
What is Active Learn and Bug Club?


This will take you to the Active Learn **log in page**. Enter your child's **username** and **password**.

The **school code** for Kirknewton Primary is: **tp6m**




After entering your child's details, you will be taken to their homepage.

It will look something like this:




Your child can now **change their home screen** by hovering over the 'My Home' tab at the top of the screen. They can choose **bug, race** or **future** world.

To **read a book and earn some active points**, click on the 'My Stuff' tab and you will see a list of books that your child's teacher has allocated to them.



To open a book just click on the one your child would like to read and it will open. You can choose to have the book read to your child or they can choose to read it themselves.



When the bug is answered, return to the book to complete it. Some bugs require a written response which teachers can see and analyse. At the end of the book you will be able to see if all bugs have been answered and then asked to add a smiley face depending on whether your child enjoyed it or not.

Rewards

In the 'My Rewards' tab, children can choose 3 different screens to play games and spend their active points in. They can:

- do races in the pit stop;
- collect stickers in the sticker factory
 - add items to a tree house

Let your child explore these screens and they will soon get the hang of it.

Additional Features and Exercises



- In the 'My Library' tab you will find the books that your child has already read that can be reread if they want to read them again. You don't earn any more points here though.
- In the 'My Stuff' tab, you may notice there is a bug tab and/or a grammar and spelling tab
- If your child's teacher has set work in these tabs, the books are held under the bug tab but active points can also be earned in the grammar and spelling tab
- There may also be a video to watch to explain a spelling or grammar rule and then games to play that are based on grammar or spelling strategies
