## 01.

### Role

- Run a once a quarter parents/carers group to support parent/carers of neurodiverse or care experienced children
- Share your knowledge of other agencies that can support neurodivergent children and their families and link us up with any key contacts you might have
- Help us work with other parents/carers who children feed into Balerno CHS to share our approaches

### Time required



This is an ongoing role which would require a maximum of the following time:

- Some time to share your experiences or knowledge with other parents and carers

### Skills, knowledge and interests
