Autistics are people just like everyone else.

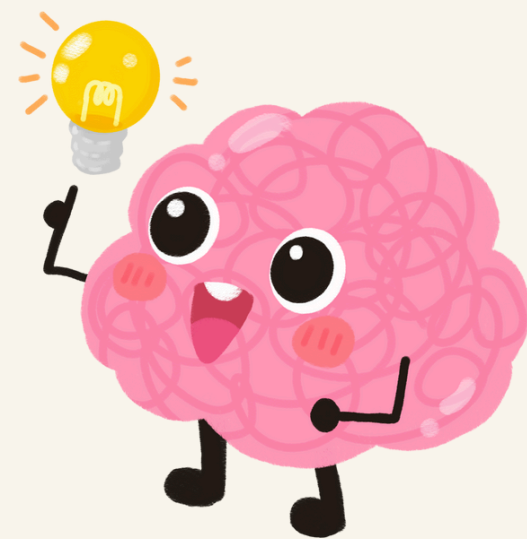

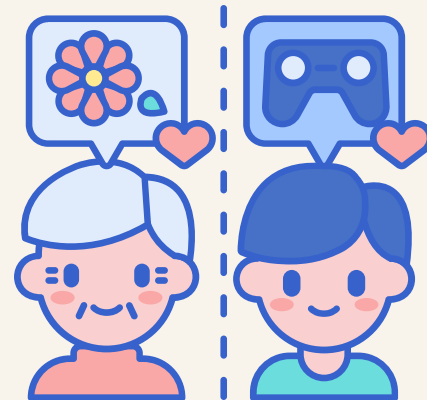


MASKING
